


Monthly Meeting:

Annual General Meeting:

At our AGM on Thursday 2nd May we elected the Committee for the coming year, as follows:

Tim Shearcroft was re-appointed as Independent Examiner.

The Annual Accounts for the Financial Year ended 31st March 2024 were approved.

The following Motions for changes to the Constitution were approved:

Motion 1:

With effect from the earliest date that any necessary approvals are obtained after the AGM held in May 2024 the Constitution shall be amended as follows: In Paragraph 1 the words "The Wissey U3A" shall be deleted and the following words substituted: "The Swaffham & District U3A".

Motion 2:

With effect from the earliest date that any necessary approvals are obtained after the AGM held in May 2024 the Constitution shall be amended as follows: In Paragraph 4.1 (iv) the words "The principal officers can serve for a maximum of 6 years and the ordinary members for a maximum of 3 years" shall be deleted and the following words substituted: "The Committee members (both principal officers and ordinary members) can serve for a maximum of 7 years."

The following Resolutions were also approved:

Resolution A:

For the purposes of Paragraph 4.1 (iv), as amended by Motion 2 above, the previous service as Committee members of those currently serving shall be discounted and the time limit of 7 years shall be counted from the date of the 2024 AGM.

Resolution B:

With effect from 1st April 2025:

The Joining Fee for a new member shall be increased from £10 to £12

The Renewal Subscription for existing members shall be increased from £8 to £10

The Joining Fee for an Associate member shall be increased from £7 to £8

The Renewal Subscription for Associate members shall be increased from £4 to £6
